#### **Higher Education Funding Note**

In the Big Bold Ask, the Prichard Committee calls for increasing Kentucky's investment in public universities, KCTCS and performance funding by \$311 million per year by 2026. The Senate Committee Substitute goes well beyond meeting those requests, with \$92 million in added investments for FY 2023 and a further \$50 million for FY 2024.

#### College Access Program (CAP) Note

CAP scholarships are Kentucky's largest needs-based financial aid program. The Senate Committee Substitute, like the House Substitute, increases that funding in each fiscal year. In the Big Bold Ask, the Prichard Committee calls for increasing Kentucky's investment in CAP by \$30 million per year by 2026, and the Senate Committee Substitute meets that goal by FY 2023.

The Senate Committee Substitute also calls for KEES to receive <u>restricted</u> funds of \$4,773,400 in FY 2023 and \$5,873,400 in FY 2024, adding additional revenue for merit scholarships
